COURSE OBJECTIVES

The purpose of the trailer towing course is to equip drivers with the skills required for someone with a B +E licence entitlement on their licence.

It will provide the driver with the skills and knowledge on how to successfully drive a vehicle with a trailer attached, along with the correct procedure on how to manoeuvre the vehicle, and to couple and uncouple the trailer. The course will also help the driver to understand weight limits and restrictions.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Drivers who have the B +E driving entitlement on their driving licence but have very little or no experience of towing a trailer.

Ideal for employers who have drivers with the B +E entitlement, to allow them to upskill their driving workforce.
